# Christmas 'Elfie' 2021 Competition



MC is a wonderfully kind lady who has steadily required more support from Bluebird Care over recent months as her mobility has declined. Following rapid assessment from the Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy Team, the carers have promptly adapted to her changing needs. To help maintain her independence and safety, two carers now visit three times daily to assist with transfers using a rotunda and stand aid. A motorised bed provided by the British Red Cross has also been installed to help improve her comfort at night and reduce pressure sore risk. The carers have been determined to ensure MC still enjoys a few 'treats' including visiting the hairdressers in the village. The team have gone above and beyond during this difficult transitional period, ensuring MC is reassured and happy.
