Criteria and Application Form for Applying for a Grant

- The organisation and/or its beneficiaries must be based in Purbeck and Wareham
- The applicant must run or coordinate a project/initiative that aims to benefit those aged 65 and over or addresses loneliness in our community. Or both!

Organisations that qualify to apply should be able to show how their work fulfils most of the following guidelines. The applicant should:-

- Include the mission statement of the organisation and web address if possible
- Provide a clear explanation of the project/initiative for which the funds are required
- Provide evidence of how the project benefits those aged 65 and over
- Provide evidence of how the project address loneliness in our community
- Provide evidence of the benefit to the community
- Use any funds granted only for the project/initiative described in the application form

Applications are more likely to succeed if they aim to support people, training skills and activities.

With the applicants permission we would like to be able to use reports about their project in any future publicity linked with Bluebird Care.
