Gifting Policy...

With Christmas fast approaching we recognise that customers and relatives may sometimes wish to express their gratitude to employees, by making gifts to them. To prevent misunderstanding and boundaries becoming blurred I would like to highlight some of the key points from our company policy regarding gifts.

- Giving or receiving gifts and favours can blur the line between a personal relationship and a professional one.
- Some customers may feel that there is an expectation to offer a tip when a good service is provided. Bluebird Care delivers its service for an agreed fee. We do not accept 'tips' on top of these fees.
- Our employees must never seek, invite or accept an offer of any form of a bequest, in cash or kind, either for themselves or their family or friends.
- If gifts are offered employees are made aware that these should be politely refused explaining this policy.
- The only exception is at Christmas when employees may accept a small gift providing it is no more than £10 in value and is not in the form of a cheque, cash or gift voucher.
- Employees are required to notify the office and document in their care notes any gifts offered, this is then also logged by the care manager on the Gifts, Hospitality and Favours Log.

I would like to reiterate that there is no exception to provide employees with gifts, however, should you wish please adhere to the above.
